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Stampbord Necklace



List of Materials:

- 1 - 2" Stampbord™
- 2 - 1" Stampbord™
- Stampbord™ Scratch Knife
- Crop-A-Dile™
- Versamark™ Ink Pad
- StazOn™ Teal Reinker
- Inktense Watercolor Pencils
- Heat Gun
- Black Diamond Embossing Powder
- 2 - Black Necklace Cords
- Spray Sealer
- 4 - Small Wood Beads
- Stamps
- Small Zip Bag
- Water Bowl
- Small Paint Brush

Step 1: (Photo a) Use the Versamark ink pad to stamp images on all three Stampbord tiles. Pour Black Diamond embossing powder on the wet ink and dump excess powder off tiles. Set with the heat gun.

Step 2: Dye wooden beads by putting them in a small zip bag with a few drops of teal StazOn Ink from Reinker. Let soak for a little while and take out to let dry.

Step 3: (Photo b) Color the Stampbord tiles with Watercolor Pencils, brush and water. Using the Stampbord Scratch Knife, scratch highlights and background details. Let dry and spray with sealer.

The Crop-a Dile is an easy way to put holes in the Stampbord.

For this project:

- 1 hole in top of 2" square
- 2 holes in each of the 1" tiles in opposite corners.

Step 4: You can string your necklace any way you like. This project has knots and beads above the 2" square and on each side of the 1" square.
